Club Championship: Joe Crissman and Craig Hurwitz Played their finals match on Saturday 10/29 at Umstead Plnes and Joe won 3&2. As has become the tradition, Carl Harris and Jim Vickery decided not to play the consolation match and therefore tied for 3rd place. KC

Most Improved Golfer: The final results are in. New member Cort Larned held on to his lead, but unfortunately did not complete the required 5 monthly events so is not eligible for the MIG title. In the final standings, Joe Gucker moved up to win the 2022 MIG while Chris Filiaci and Robby Robinson came in 2nd and 3rd respectively. KC

Golfer of the Year: WGC's 2022 Golfer of the Year (GOY) competition has wrapped up with Chris Rook completing a dominating championship run. Teeing off, 4 players had a chance at 1st place but by day's end, there were no position changes in the top 4. For the season's last official GOY event, Chris earned the maximum 121 points, 100 for 1st individual net and 21 for 1st team net. Chris' best 7/10 scores total of 597 far outpaced 2nd place Jonathan Adams (80 + 6 = 86) who earned a respectable 86 points chasing Chris on the final day for a best 7/10 total of 507. That is how you close out a great season with the overall GOY Championship. Well Done, Chris, wow what a great year! Rounding out the GOY top 5 were 3rd place Dave Tinker (56 final round points, best 7/10 total of 452), 4th Robby Robinson (41 final round points, 432 points for best 7/10), and 5th KC Hustvedt (46, 402). The only position change in the top 5 after the last event was KC swapping with Lenny Walsh (31, 397) for 5th and 6th place. Thanks to everyone that participated in all of our events this year. We had a number of great performances along the way. I'm already looking forward to doing it again next year. LW

October 22nd Outing at River Ridge GC Roller Coaster round: Beautiful weather greeted our group of 18 players 17 members and 1 guest) for our last official event of this year played 10/22/22 on a very challenging River Ridge GC layout. The course was in excellent condition with lightening fast greens that made almost any shot ending up above the hole a very tough 2 putt. Robby once again came up with a fun format, roller coaster, where the number of scores counted per hole varied as 1, 2, 3, 3, 2, 1 over 6 holes then repeated for the duration. Chris Rook was our individual low net leader with a fine round of net 69. Rounding out the top 5 individual net scores were Jerry Derner, Jonathan Adams, Chris Filiaci, and Tyson Yorkey who all had nice net 71s. The team of Chris Rook, KC Hustvedt, Jerry Derner, and Jonathan McCarron won team net 1st place with 125. Teams Dave Tinker, Doug Noell, Chris Filiaci, and Maura Stokes tied 2nd with Robby Robinson, Tyson Yorkey, Keith Jackson plus a Greg Best blind at 127. LW.

Championship match story

Craig Hurwitz vs Joe Crissman

On Saturday October 29, 2022, the long awaited match between myself and Craig Hurwitz happened on Umstead Pines golf course. In attendance and playing along for 18 holes was Mr. Lenny Walsh and Mr. Doug Noell joined us at the halfway point. Doug did not play, he only rode with Lenny and was from what he said very happy to just watch a match and not chase a silly white ball all over the place. That was the only time in history that Doug Noell went 9 holes on a golf course without slicing a golf ball, not even once!

First off I want to thank Craig Hurwitz for making it a fun round of golf and congratulate him for making it to the club championship match. It is truly amazing to me that a first year member made the run he did into the championship match. I could not have picked a better person to play in the final match. He made the match comfortable from stroke one on the first tee until the last putt on #18. While discussing the match we decided to play a non stressful match, just have a fun round. We supported each other the whole round, rooting for good shots all day. As normal, the shots were not all good which led to several No, No, No, don't do that...from both of us, usually at the same time. Craig is a great competitor and was extremely gracious when he conceded the match.

Now to the match, after discussing ground rules between ourselves and Lenny (being he is the rule guru), we teed off at 1 pm. We both played from the white tees thus I was giving Craig 4 strokes, 2 on the front and back nine. On hole one Craig put his drive through the fairway into the trees and I was in the fairway. I pulled my second and hit a low tree branch and Craig hit it short of the green. After I pitched onto the green Craig almost sunk his third shot by hitting the pin leaving a 12 inch putt for par. I gave him the putt giving him a par getting a stroke giving him a 4 for a 3, and Craig was up one hole early. We both parred 2 and I evened the match on hole 3 with a par and Craig getting a bogie. On hole #4 Craig found a tree with his drive and second shot and a fairway bunker with his 3 shot, only to hit a great sand shot to the green! I won the hole with a bogie and Craig 3 putt for a double bogie. I was up 1 hole going into #5. Craig got a stroke on #5, he found a bit of trouble getting to the green helping me out as we tied the hole. On hole 6 we both hit good drives, in fact only a few feet apart, we both reached the green in 2. I sank a 35-40 foot putt for birdie and Craig missed his birdie putt putting me 2 up. #7 par 3 we both hit the green, I 3 putt and Craig 2 putt to put me 1 up. On # 8, we both hit drives through the fairway leaving tough shots to the green. I hit the green and again 3 putt for a bogie on the hole while Craig had more problems and got a double bogie putting me back 2 up. On # 9, we both had good drives, Craig put a fantastic second shot on the green and 1 putt for an Eagle to win the hole. I had a birdie putt but that doesn't beat an Eagle. I was 1 up at the turn thanks to Craig's awesome second shot and a fantastic 30 foot Eagle putt.

On the back 9 I won holes 10, 11 and 12 to go 4 up. I missed birdie putts on holes 10 and 11 where Craig had some problems on both holes. We both had problems on par 3 # 12 and I won the hole after 4 putting for a double bogie. Emoji Craig didn't give up being down 4 with 6 to play! Craig won holes 13 and 14 with a bogie on 13 and par on 14 to put me up 2 with 4 to play. On hole 15, I got a par and Craig got a bogey with a stroke so we tied the hole leaving the match 2 up with 3 to go. On the par 5 16th hole we both hit good drives and good second shots, almost right beside each other. We had a lot of shots sitting right next to each other throughout the day. Craig's approach shot ended up short, my approach shot stopped about 5 feet from the hole. Craig tried to hole his 4th shot and hit it too hard and it went off the back of the green, after 3 more shots he conceded the hole and the match. My par ended the match with me 3 up with 2 to go. I parred # 17 and Craig bogeyed it and we both bogeyed #18 to end our day.

Umstead Pines was in good condition and the greens were rolling great, not River Ridge fast but way faster than I have seen before. The weather was cool in the 60's, overcast and some wind but a comfortable day to be playing golf.

Once again I want to thank Craig Hurwitz for a fun stress free round! It was an honor to play with him and I look forward to seeing him again in the future in the Championship match because he will be back! I want to thank all the people I played with in this tournament, Patty Tinker, Bill McGee, Joe Gucker, Jim Vickery and for Swood giving me a spanking in my first match. Tournaments

- Team Format - 6/6/6 Partner Event
 - Holes 1-6: Best Ball (100% course strokes)
 - Holes 7-12: Low Gross score and other Net score (100% course strokes)
 - Holes 13-18: Captain's Choice (35% lower strokes plus 15% higher strokes)
- Payouts
 - As much fun as you can have
 - Random draw for free rounds, must play but do not need to be present at the end of round to win!
 - Lively discussion of "best shot of the day" for a free round (each group picks one and then a group debate)

Captain's Responsibilities (player listed first on scorecard)

- It's a fun event but we still need to emphasize pace of play!
- During the round:
 - Record group's time off the 1st tee
 - Record each player's gross hole scores; if a player reaches their max score (net double bogey) and does not hole out, record their max score with an "X" next to it
 - If your group falls behind the group in front, implement the WGC Pace of Play guidelines to close the gap as quickly as possible
- At the end of the round:
 - Record time off last green and calculate your round time interval
 - Total the team scores (front, back, overall)
 - Sign the scorecard and turn it in as soon as possible

Local Rules (See WGC Terms of Competition for additional information)

- Out of bounds – defined by the inside edge of painted white lines or the line between the inside edge of the white stakes and the **fence to the left of the green on #17**
- Drop Zones – On the **par 3 hole #5** over water, the drop zone is on the far side of the green.
- Round duration – target round duration here is 4:15, it's an easy walk and ride so please keep up and do better than that
- Dangerous conditions – If you deem the weather conditions to be unsafe, it is your responsibility to seek shelter immediately. If you do so, you will not be penalized, and, if you cannot return and finish your round, blinds will be substituted for holes you did not play. Otherwise, you should return to play as soon as the unsafe condition passes, or, in the case that the course stopped play, when the course deems conditions to be safe
- Lift, clean, and place within a club length no closer to the hole
 - In sand bunkers (don't create a tee!)
 - Anywhere through the green (not in penalty areas), including if roots or rocks interfere with your lie or stroke
